DESIGNATED TRAVEL TIMES

ARRIVALS: For the Texas, Colorado, and California LDZ programs, the recommended flight arrival times are from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM.

DEPARTURES: Departing flights should be scheduled after 1:00 PM in order to provide ample time to check baggage, pass security, etc.

NOTE: It will be the responsibility of the student and family to arrange for transportation from the airport to and from the university. Please see [NHI COVID Policies](#) & [In--Person Program Information](#).

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION CAREFULLY

IMPORTANT TRAVEL DISCLOSURE: All students are individually responsible for making their travel arrangements to and from their respective program. The cost of travel to the program destination is not included in the program tuition. Additionally, the tuition does not include transportation from the airport to the university. NHI will ask for detailed travel information to ensure students are accounted for. As a reminder, NHI will not provide shuttle service from the airport, bus, or train station to the LDZ program campus.

On the first day of the LDZ/registration day, NHI volunteers will be in the baggage claim area during the designated times wearing colorful t-shirts that say “LDZ”. They will also have signs that say “NHI” and/or “LDZ”. These volunteers will confirm that students arrived safely and have available a list of local transportation options.

Please be aware that if your student arrives before our recommended arrival times, there may not be an NHI volunteer on hand to greet her/him. Similarly, if your child arrives after 4:00 PM, your student may not make it for dinner which is normally scheduled for 5:00 PM. Therefore, please make preparations and instruct your student to grab a light dinner before leaving the airport if they are arriving after 4:00 PM or late in the evening.

Students and families may also make private arrangements to and from the university. We ask that you inform us of those plans so that we are prepared to welcome your child. Also, if you know that your child will arrive outside of the recommended times, we also recommend you communicate with us so that we can capture all the details and make arrangements.

If your child is traveling internationally, we recommend you provide NHI with copies of international travel documents and communicate with the LDZ staff about departure requirements.

Frequently Asked Travel Questions

As parents, we understand that you may be a bit cautious about sending your son/daughter traveling without you to a new and unfamiliar location. We understand that you would like to learn more about this process and what NHI will do to ensure a great and safe experience for your young scholar. We have prepared this document with a list of standard questions parents have about student travel to an NHI experience. Hopefully, this document will prove helpful and answer most of your questions or concerns. Q: How can I notify NHI of my child's travel itinerary so that I can ensure their participation at the LDZ?

A: We request that you fill out our Travel Information form online. Submit your 2021 LDZ Summer Travel information [HERE](#) (click link)

Q: Should I purchase my child's travel even if there is still a tuition balance on his/her account?

A: No. Your child's participation remains secure as long as you keep your tuition payments current and certainly and will be confirmed once the tuition is fully paid. Unfortunately, we cannot confirm students for participation the day of the program despite them having travel arrangements. We strongly encourage you to contact NHI Enrollment at admissions@nhimail.com to make a payment to settle any outstanding balance.

Q: If I or a family member will drive my child to the program site on the first day, do we still need to notify NHI of my child's travel arrangements?

A: Yes. Even if your child will not require airport transportation, it is still very important for you to submit your child's travel information online. We want to make sure we can greet and expect your child on campus.

Q: Who will meet my child at the airport when he/she arrives?

A: As long as your child arrives within the specified window of the arrival time, NHI volunteers will be at the airport in the baggage claim area. Our NHI volunteers will be wearing NHI program t-shirts and will have a designated leader who will have a list of arriving students. Students will be directed to local transportation options. While we cannot guarantee a personal greeter for students who arrive after the designated times, we will do our best to communicate with the students. Feel free to connect with us directly with specific questions.

Q: If my child’s flight is delayed or he/she misses it, what should we do?

A: Please contact the LDZ On-Site Director of your respective program by phone. The LDZ On-Site Director will oversee the schedule and events for this program. That person’s name and phone number will be provided to you in your LDZ Final Confirmation Packet, which is emailed 3-4 weeks prior to your program. You may also contact NHI directly the day of the program at 512-357-6137. Our main office is always open the day a program begins during “pick up” times. Feel free to also email admissions@nhimail.com as that account is regularly checked especially on weekends during the summer.

Q: What day does my child need to arrive at the airport for his/her program and what day does he/she need to depart from the airport?

A: Your child should arrive on the starting date of the program and should depart on the ending date of the program. Neither NHI, nor the university, can provide lodging, meals, transportation, and/or security for students arriving day(s) before or after the scheduled LDZ program dates.

Q: What time should my child’s flight arrive at the airport on the first day and what time should my child depart on the last day?

A: NHI Volunteers, who will be greeting your child at the airport, will be there between 10:00 AM - 2:00 PM. To ensure your child is greeted at the airport by NHI Volunteers, book your child’s flight to arrive between 11 a.m-3:00p.m. Book your child’s return flight after 1:00 PM to allow ample time to check baggage, pass security, etc.

Q: What if he/she cannot arrive during the designated dates and/or times?

A: If your child cannot arrive during the designated times, we ask that you share this information in the [LDZ Summer Travel Form](#).

Q: What if my child will arrive before 10:00 AM on the designated date of the program?

A: Your child may have to wait patiently until 10:00 AM when an NHI volunteer arrives to greet students at the baggage claim. Students are always encouraged to contact the LDZ On-Site Director to inform them of their arrival.

Q: What if my child has a late evening flight on the designated date of departure?

A: Your child will have to make arrangements to depart the campus no later than 12:00 PM to the airport. NHI cannot and will not leave students unaccompanied on campus after the program ends. If you are picking up your child from the program they must be picked up by 11:00 AM.

Q: Can my child drive his/her own vehicle to the program site?

A: No. For the safety of all students and liability purposes, students are not permitted to bring their own vehicle on-campus for the duration of the program.

Q: Does NHI provide housing, meals, and/or supervision for my child outside of the designated program dates?

A: Unfortunately, NHI cannot accommodate early date arrivals or late date departures. If your child must arrive or depart outside of the designated program dates, we are not held liable and he/she will have to arrange his/her own accommodations. Please note that if your child is departing after the ending date of the program, NHI must have written consent releasing your child from our care.
