For 38 years, student participants of NHI's summer leadership programs have continued to recognize that their journey involves much more than attending conferences; Mastering the skills, insight and knowledge necessary for leadership, as well as having opportunities to test and evaluate your potential, requires a continuous and active pursuit of self-development. In joining the NHI alumni network, you have gained membership to an institution that values your development as a future leader of the community, and has made it a priority to expand your capacities.

The NHI High School Summer Leadership Series builds students' basic skills and capacities. After you enroll in college, you are invited to continue your leadership journey as a member of NHI's Collegiate Leadership Network (CLN). After graduating from college, you become part of the young professional association as an apprentice leadership trainer in summer leadership programs and community-based projects. Older, more established professional alumni carry out major leadership initiatives on behalf of NHI in the United States and Latin America.

New opportunities for personal development, beyond the formal training of college and careers, prepare youth to participate in the civic aspects of community life. The Collegiate World Series (CWS), the capstone experience of NHI's high school Summer Leadership Series, ties together three years of NHI Leadership Development. Graduates of both the Great Debate and the Lorenzo de Zavala Youth Legislative Session test all of their acquired skills and develop them at the next level. This five-day experience comprises two parts: the League Series and the Thought Series. In the first, participants spend over a day and a half amplifying their understanding of the admissions and financial aid processes led by admissions professionals from NHI's College Register. Through the partnership with University representatives, students acquire insight into their journey through the University application process and life in college. The challenges they will face, and how to handle real world dilemmas give them an important advantage over their local classmates as they enter their senior year of high school. The Thought Series follows in a competition format where students explore Inquiry Based Learning as a tool of leadership. Using this NHI learning strategy, participants work in teams to evaluate business models and address real world challenges. Students present their plans for consideration as community investment opportunities, strengthening their capacities of executive level skills. After participating in the Collegiate World Series, students contribute in higher levels with the National Hispanic Institute, their college campus, and local community. Students walk away as more evaluative, self-managed, and self-directed leaders excited to develop a new generation of Latino leaders.



International CWS

The International CWS, the premier destination for NHI's Latin American students, holds a hemispheric delegation and multinational character. At the gorgeous Saint Leo University in Florida, University admissions representatives from southern colleges call this program home. Palm trees and tropical weather add a positive atmosphere to the highly intellectual and international student discussions held at this conference.
